DONATIONS TO SCHOOL

So far since September we have raised just over **£4,000** for the school and the children and a large proportion of this has been donated to school in the following ways. £1,000 has been given to help fund the school trips, which will take place in terms 5 and 6. We have also paid for the school's TV licence of £130. More recently you may have noticed that all the classrooms have new flat screen pc monitors, which have again been funded through the FOS. These 13 monitors cost £1,325. Finally £200 was given to each class teacher for them to spend as they wish within their classroom; this was a further £1,200 donated. We still have some funds to give and at present are in discussion with the staff as to how it should be spent. We will keep you updated.

Everybody was so generous and we hope you will be again this time. These prizes will be collected a couple of weeks before the event.

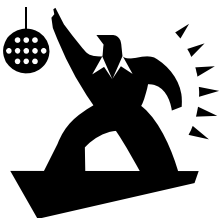
We are conscious that this is a lot to ask, and really do appreciate your generosity. We will send out reminders about these stalls again nearer the time.
