<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mrs Chrystal told parents about the excitement in school over the hatching chicks. • A parent asked if the school would take a dance group to the 'Bromley Heath Festival' again this year. Mrs Chrystal said that the school would be pleased to do this again. The parent then thanked the staff for giving up their time at the weekend again this year. • Mrs Chrystal informed the group that school had just been awarded a platinum Outdoor Play And Learning(OPAL) award for our outdoor play provision. This is a very prestigious award and Mrs Chrystal explained that this was the result of good team work within the school and the wider community. • We discussed the addition of pathways between the new equipment. The school council and the playground team have made some plans. They include paths using different materials and possibly rubberised tarmac. • Mrs Chrystal also invited the parents to stay and play at school until 3.30 but reminded them that it was their responsibility to watch their children and the oak tree is out of bounds.
