- *Signposting to agencies that may be able to support you and your family e.g. bereavement support, behaviour management, Parenting courses etc*

If you would like to talk to me about anything, please pass a note to me via your child's class when you drop them off in the morning or speak to me to arrange an appointment. I can be found on Giraffe Class door most mornings and would love to meet you. I am available to listen to your concerns from 2.50-3.10pm most afternoons. Sometimes just sharing those little worries & concerns can make a big difference so please don't be afraid to talk about them.
