Real P.E – we will be practising jumping and landing and seated balances.

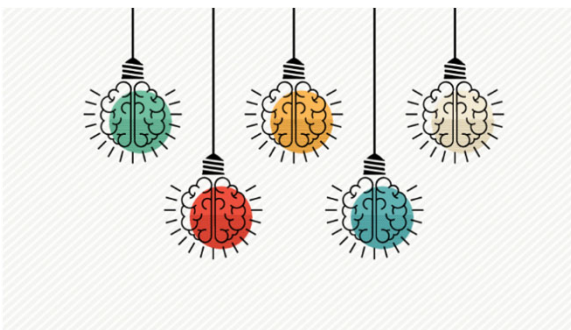
Classroom – we will use tools safely and practise our fine and gross motor skills.
