Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update

It has been another busy and productive week in Giraffes and Zebras! EYFS have been following their key text 'Tom and The Island of the dinosaurs', learning about fossils, volcanoes, hot air balloons and islands. When I was in EYFS this week, I was very impressed by their drawing play projects, with detailed volcanoes, and their concentration. Amazing! They also enjoyed looking at Google Earth and finding islands including The United Kingdom and other places in the world that they had visited.

In year one, they have been learning about what life was like in a Medieval Castle. Following on from their trip, they found out about jobs different people did and then engaged in role-play, pretending to be, for example cooks and knights. Penguin and Lion are really focused on their writing at the moment: they have been working on using exclamation marks to write speech bubbles from different characters and finally, wrote a diary entry as that character.

Year two have excelled in sport this week, both in achievement and in their terrific team spirit. On Saturday, a group of eight children (Lani, Mimi, Evan, Ed, Herbie, Harry R, Harry L and Theo), won gold at the 'Festival of Youth Sport'. Their team working and determination was much praised by Mrs Warren and Mrs James who accompanied them. More team spirit was in evidence on Thursday when Leopard and Dolphin classes participated at the MAD Olympiad. Special mention to Ed who won the gold medal in the Egg and Spoon final; to both Dolphin and Leopard relay teams as they won their heats, and to Leopard relay who then went on to win a medal in the final. However, we were very proud of ALL the children, who have received a special 'Bromley Bear' certificate for being the best they could be as every child gave each activity their all and supported their team throughout.

All classes have also been practising for sports day, including a whole-school practice today. We were again so proud of the children who cheered each other on and were determined to do their best. Our sports day is on Tuesday afternoon, which currently looks to have a good chance of being dry and going ahead; if not the reserve is Thursday afternoon. We hope to see you there!
