Their play projects have involved demonstrating their learning about triceratops, diplodocus and tyrannosaurus-rex - if you have children in EYFS, I am sure they will be able to tell you lots of information about them. Having spent Wednesday morning in EYFS, I am so impressed with the development in their reading: not just of the words but also the understanding. Keep it up Giraffe and Zebras!

Looking less further back, the year ones visited the Medieval Barn in Winterbourne this week. They enjoyed a range of different activities, including dressing up in medieval style clothes, looking at food eaten during medieval times, sweeping the floor, washing clothes, sketching in the cottage garden and tasting pottage. A great start to their local history theme this term!

Our Year twos also loved their trip to the M Shed to support their learning about Bristol in the past. They learnt all about what it was like to work as a sailor in the 17th century aboard The Bristol Merchant, including practising tying knots, stitching sails, and coiling ropes. The children were shocked to find that 10 year olds worked as cabin boys. They also followed the Bristol History trail investigating and sketching different exhibits: they especially liked finding our school on the big map of Bristol. A favourite part of the day was eating the bacon sandwiches (and vegetarian alternatives) kindly provided by Mr Kohn and The Jolly Hog. Thank you!

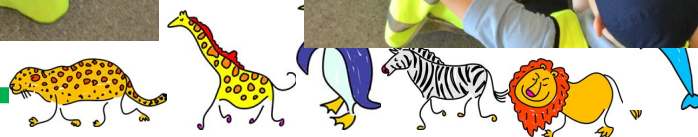
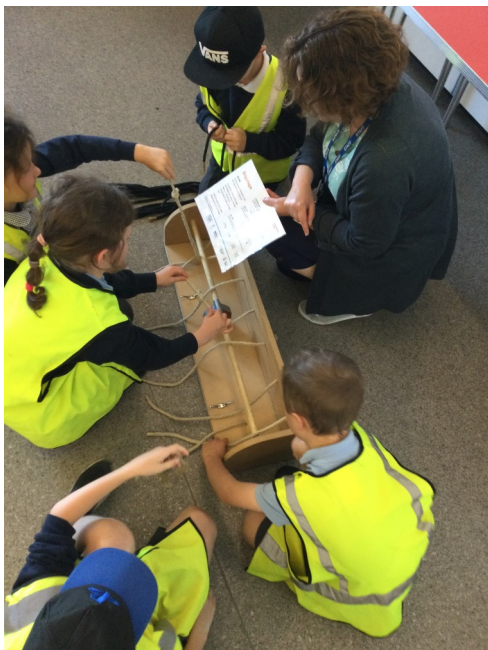
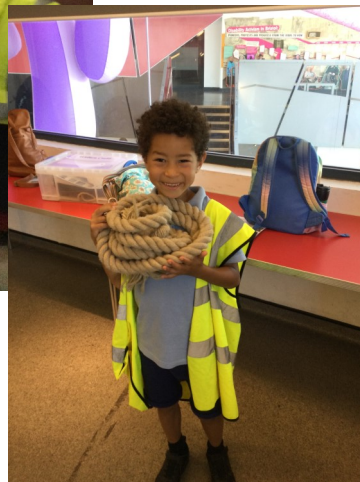
Happy News!

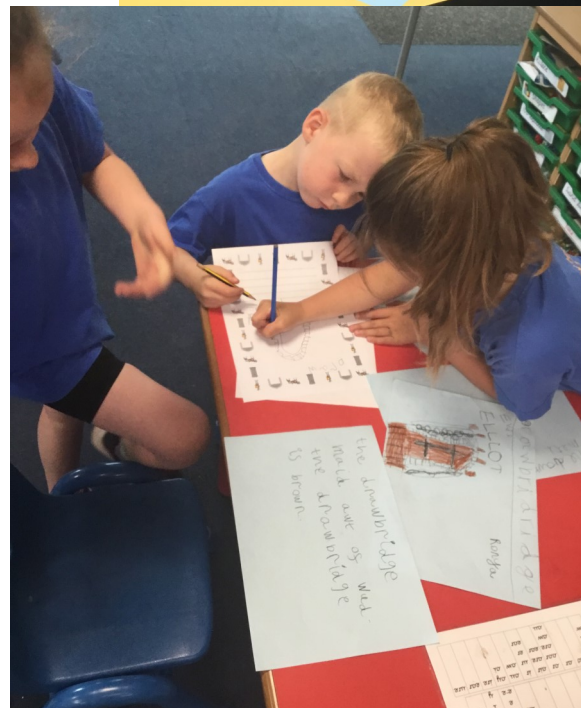
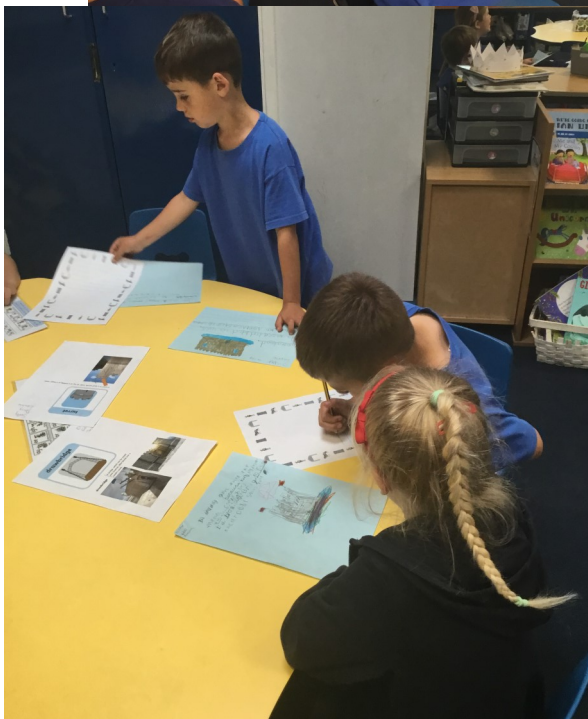
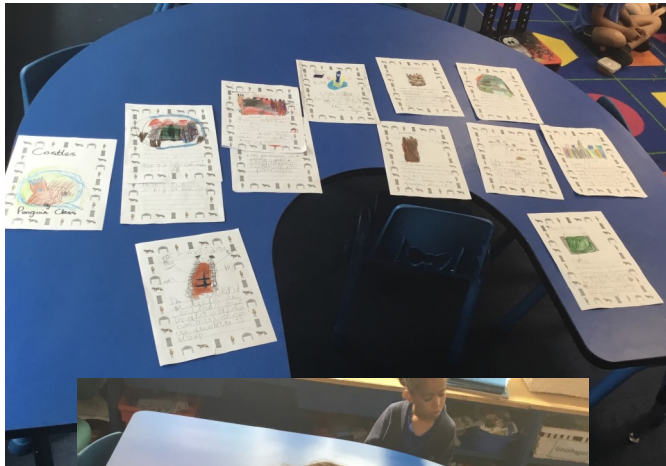




Medieval Barn—Y1 trip
