We are always proud of our art at BHI and think we achieve high outcomes. This week, the children's skills and love of the subject have been evident throughout the school.

In EYFS, the children continued with their step-by-step dinosaurs, this time drawing brontosaurus and then putting the skills they have been working on by drawing the various dinosaurs, together in a scene, based on their core text 'Tom and the Island of Dinosaurs'.

In year one, the children have continued to be engaged with dragons, linking to their work on castles. They have designed their own dragon, using imagination and sketching skills, adding brilliant descriptions to match. Year two have been working with clay sculpture: first of all, creating pinch pots, (revising skills learnt in year one when they also made diyas); then moving onto making clay relief tiles, using impressing and joining techniques to create seaside or underwater scenes. It has been a great challenge!

As the classes were not in school today, Giraffe, Zebra and Penguin will give certificates to the children in their classes on Monday. Thank you to all families who have already returned the 'Raisin Box Challenge' and well done to those children who earned some extra funds for the school through acts of kindness. Thank you to our amazing Friends of School also for organising this. Our school budget is extremely challenging at the moment, largely due to increases in gas and electricity costs and inflationary costs on all resources ordered, so money raised is even more valuable than usual.

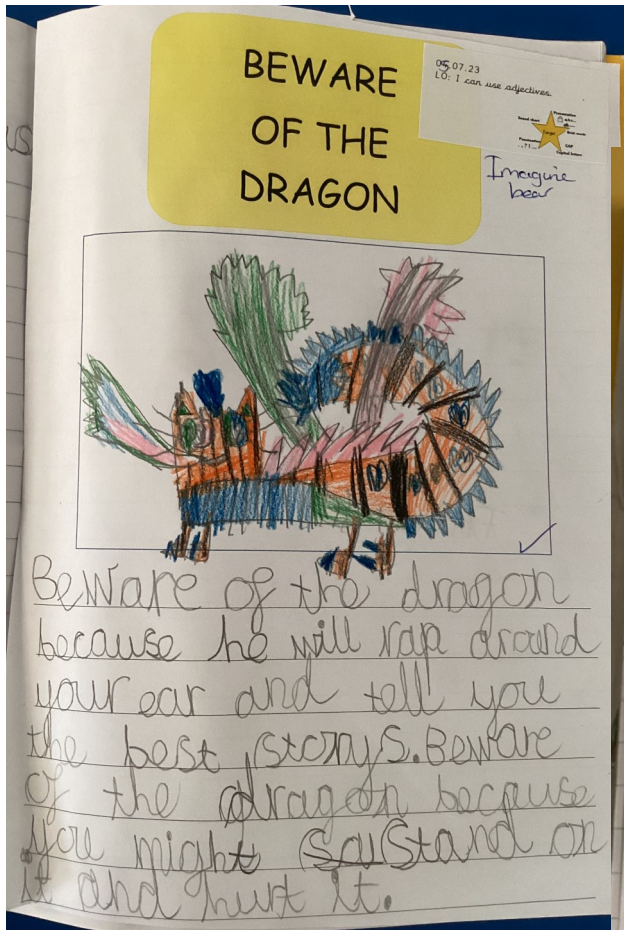

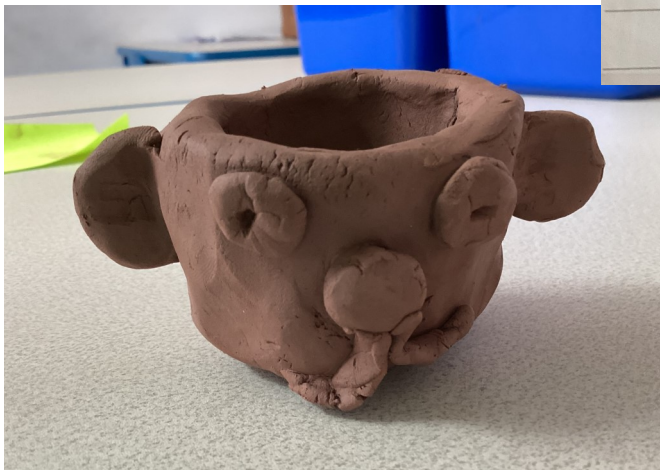
