Real PE

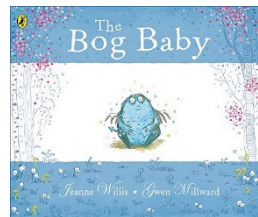
We will be following the Real PE scheme which is developing skills and agility through a story based approach.

Computing
