We have had a lovely, productive week in school. Our theme in term one is 'Where are we?' and as part of this our year two enjoyed the first school trip of the year. After being dropped by the SS Great Britain, they boarded a boat for a trip around the harbour; sketched boats and cranes on the harbour side, then moved to Queen's Square to sketch buildings and monuments before getting the bus to Brandon Hill, giving tremendous views across Bristol. The trip gave them a great start to their geography topic and will be helpful to revisit during their history topic later in the term.

Our year ones have been learning more about the school grounds — investigating different places using 'journey sticks' (ask your children if this is also new to you!). I was impressed by their descriptive writing about 'Bog Baby' this week and what great 'Concentrate Bears' the children were on their tutor tables.




