Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update

What an active week EYFS have had. They began their forest schools sessions and learnt the Forest school motto: 'we look after ourselves, each other and our world'. They had a brilliant time climbing, building, digging and listening to all the different noises they could hear. They loved exploring through bug and scavenger hunts and had a great adventure. Fantastic 'Try New Things' and 'Imagine Bears'!

In year one, the children have continued their learning about autumn. Their writing on the tutor table has all been based around weather, which they have also been thinking about in science play projects: making weather vanes, rain sticks and wind turbines; recording the weather daily, and using pictograms to represent frequency. After learning the nations in the United Kingdom, they then produced weather reports for the four capital cities. Their book club this week has been celebrating key figures in Black History, including Ella Fitzgerald and Martin Luther King.

In year two, the children have been studying St Lucia in geography, investigating human and physical geographical features and comparing these to the UK. In English, they have read about the island and the people who live there, writing fact files and persuasive posters to encourage people to visit the island. Following on from this, next week, they will consider the experience of the Windrush generation to the UK.

## Frequently asked questions:

What kind of activities do you do? All of our activities are social stimulators, working in groups and teams. The majority are physical activities such as team games, playground games and different sports. However we do give the children some respite in the day with quizzes, crafts and other calm activities.

Should my child bring lunch? Yes, please provide your child with a packed lunch, a snack for breaktimes and a refillable water bottle.

What qualifications do your staff hold? Our staff are all enhanced DBS and work within Primary schools during term time. They hold or are working towards NGB level 2 coaching qualifications as a minimum and hold First Aid and Safeguarding qualifications.
