## Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update

In EYFS, this term the team have started a new teaching and learning session called 'Drawing Club' where the children respond to a different book or short film each week, solving problems within the narratives. It is proving a great success: creativity is shining through, with imaginative drawing and early writing flowing (ask your children about their monsters and robots!)

Our year ones had a very exciting start to the week as their weekly forest school session had a special focus - fire! As part of their learning about Bonfire Night and Guy Fawkes in history, they watched the flames from a fire on the field and when it died down, they loved toasting marshmallows and especially eating the delicious treat! Following this, they have all been fantastic 'Imagine Bears', creating poetry based on fire including a range of descriptive vocabulary.

In year two, history learning has continued this week with the children benefitting from two visitors to enhance their understanding. Linda, from the Kingswood Museum, shared WW1 and WW2 artefacts, which the children were able to investigate, and historian Jack Brittain shared his experience of being a child in WW2. Having spent time considering questions to ask the visitors, afterwards they wrote thank you letters using some of the skills they have been working on in English (such as conjunctions to give reasons) . Great 'Understand Others Bears' year two!



In Year One, Penguins and Lions, thought about the experience of the soldiers and significance of Remembrace Sunday, making poppies and building model Cenotaphs.










# Remembrance reflections and learning


