Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update

Our EYFS this week have been making the most of the outdoor environment: using the outside blocks to build projects; creating mud-kitchen recipes, and using magnifying glasses to investigate natural objects in detail. In their artists' club, they have also been drawing autumn trees (step by step) and reading a variety of Supertato books in Book Club.

In year one, the children have continued working on paper sculptures, putting the skills learnt into a final piece and creating gorgeous tree sculptures. Terrific 'Imagine Bears', they have also been working hard to include adjectives within their writing about Stick Man, innovating the story to create their own version. They enjoyed a lovely play project yesterday, bringing a teddy in from home and celebrating the big moments so far in their lives, such as starting school, learning to ride a bike or to swim.

Following on from 'Jonathan's Jungle Roadshow' visit in year two, when Jonathan introduced the seven life processes, this week Leopards and Dolphins have been learning about features of living things, grouping them in different ways. In English, they have innovated the story of 'Last Stop on the Reindeer Express', writing their own versions and focusing on including adjectives and adverbs. They have been real 'Keep Going Bears' in their maths lessons, learning to add and subtract using the column method.

Finally, a huge thank you to our ever-supportive Friends of School, who funded a theatre visit this week, who performed a production of Cinderella. It was great fun and has inspired the children before their own performances in the next few weeks.

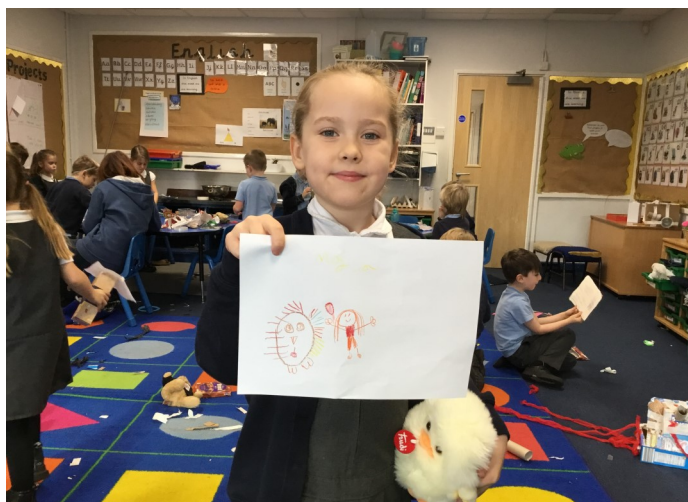
