Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update



Our EYFS this week have been completing lots of learning around 'The Three Little Pigs'. In their play projects, they have built or painted the houses for the different pigs; listed items they need for their build; created settings; made masks and puppets of the pigs or wolf, and drawn story maps. In writing groups, they have captioned pictures from the story and enjoyed lots of role play activities.

Year one continue to be enthused by space: this week learning about astronaut Neil Armstrong (next week, Mae Jemison), as well as writing their own, innovated versions of 'The Way Back Home', based on their key text. I have been very impressed with the writing that I have seen.

In year two, 'The Tin Forest' continues to inspire the children's writing, art and science. They have thought of vibrant adjectives to describe the tropical jungle; written setting descriptions, and finally letters in role as the old man to invite people to see the incredible forest. In art, they have worked imaginatively on metallic sculptures aiming to create a collaborative 'Tin Forest', by twisting, crumpling and shaping tin foil.

As part of our 'Cracking Inventions' theme this term, the whole school is working on materials in science: in EYFS, they are spotting different materials (and comparing mass in maths); in year one, the children have been comparing properties of materials and completing investigations about the most effective material for a astronaut's spacesuit, and in year two the children have been investigating which materials are waterproof and robust enough to make a roof for the house in 'The Tin Forest' as there is a leak.

Thank you to all families who were able to attend workshops this week; feedback was that they were very informative about what the classes are learning and how to support children with this. If you were unable to come, please do look at the materials that were used.



What we'll do

A fun way to get children in Years 1 - 3 into coding. They will use specialist software to enjoy learning coding skills. Beginning with simple movement commands, then progress to actions such as "when clicked" and sounds. More advanced skills such as "collision detection" and "if/else" action commands will also be covered. They will be asked to create coding scenes at the end of each session that cover skills learned in that particular session, as well as previous sessions. The final project will be a game they create that they can then show off to friends and family via a shareable link.
