Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update

What a fantastic art week at BHI to end our 'What's at the Bottom of the Garden?' theme! During art week, we aim to revisit and extend sketching and painting skills that the children have been learning over the year, as well as to enrich and inspire their growing artistic talents.

Every child has painted a canvas. In EYFS, these are inspired by the artwork in their key text: 'The Little Gardener' by Emily Hughes; in Y1, inspired by the Van Gogh painting 'The Pink Peach Tree in Blossom' and in Y2 David Hockney, 'Late November Tunnel'. The skills of tinting and colour mixing in EYFS; of colour mixing, tints, shades and impasto brushstrokes in Y1, and colour mixing, graduated tints, shades and perspective (to a vanishing point) in Y2, show clearly how the children's art skills develop over the three years. In addition, EYFS and year one revisited sculpture: in EYFS, creating colourful, clay mini-beasts and in year one, paper sculptures of birds - both also displayed. The bird theme continued into year two, where this term in D and T, the children have learnt to sew using a running stitch and applied this skill to create the beautiful fabric birds you will see.

This year, to enrich the children's creative experience, we have focused on textiles. The artist, Ruth Bullock, worked with every child across the school: in EYFS, the children learnt to use 'brusho' paint with oil pastels to create flowers; in year one, the children learnt mono-printing to create leaves on cotton, and in year two, the children made felt and used this to create individual leaves. Ruth then put all of this work together in a collaborative piece for our school hall, (permanently) displayed on the back wall of the gallery. Ask your child to spot their contribution!

We hope you enjoy the art gallery as much as we have all enjoyed creating it; all individual work will go home next term so we ask that you do not take your children's work today as we want all visitors to be able to enjoy the complete experience. Thank you to our Friends of School, who funded this week - the canvases, Ruth's workshops and materials; we would not be able to do so much without your support. Finally, a HUGE thank you to our incredible Mrs Woodhams, who leads and champions art through our school. This week would not have happened without her dedication, enthusiasm and creativity.

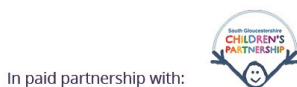

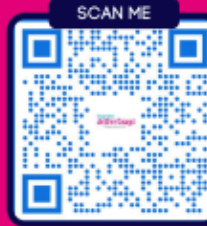
