Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update

This week, we have been focusing on our 'Understand Others Bear', encouraging the children to 'be kind, listen and think about others'. To be successful, we have been talking to the children about the need to listen to others and respond with care. Our top tips to them for being a great 'Understand Others Bear' are that kindness spreads happiness to everyone and to think about how they can help others.

Our curriculum theme this term is 'Where am I?' This week, our EYFS have had their first forest school sessions, exploring beyond their classroom. In year one, the children have been on a 'school hunt walk', challenging themselves to find all the places and objects from their search lists. They are also loving 'Bog Baby' - their key text for this term and were very excited to find him in their classrooms this morning! Our year twos have been learning about human and physical features in Bristol: after sharing photographs taken in the city from the summer holidays, and discussing where they are found, they went on a school trip to spot various features. Thankfully, the rain largely held off and they enjoyed a boat trip - with a very informative guide; sketched features from the harbourside and then walked to Queen's Square. Both year one and two have also been working on drawing skills, with year one focusing on the artist Bridget Riley and investigating different lines and in year two, learning different shading techniques to create tone and texture.
