



Our newsletter this week contains our star learners and bear certificates for both today and for last Thursday as Friday 11th was an INSET day.

Last week, we focused on being a 'Work Well Bear', encouraging the children to 'try your best - lots of effort leads to success'. To be a successful 'Work Well Bear', we have been talking to the children about the need to 'practise, practise and practise again!'. Our top tips to them for being a great 'Work Well Bear' are to try hard and enjoy their work and to remember that there are no shortcuts to success. This week, we thought about what being an 'Improve Bear' means, explaining that by improving things, we make good things great. Our top tips to them for being an amazing 'Improve Bear' are to take their time and do their best and to make small changes to make things even better.

Our EYFS are continuing to impress and not just in phonics! Over the past few weeks in their music sessions, they have learnt about pulse, pitch and rhythm. They have used clapping to keep a steady pulse, changed their voices to create different pitches and moved their bodies to different songs to learn about rhythm. All very good fun! In year one, they have been learning about the United Kingdom, which countries belong to it and different famous landmarks. They have also been weather presenters this week; role-playing weather reports for parts of the UK and making various weather-related instruments, and landmarks, in play projects. They have also been reading stories about inspirational figures as part of black history month e.g. about the Bristol bus boycotts and Rosa Parks who affected positive change. In year two, the children have been becoming experts on St Lucia in both English and topic: they have been learning all about the foods, animals and features of St Lucia and have displayed their knowledge on some super leaflets, making sure to include all the features of a non-fiction text. They also compared life in St Lucia to life in Bromley Heath before drawing lovely comic strips to display this. Next week, they will continue learning about St Lucia by considering the contributions of the Windrush generation to the UK. In maths, the children have been impressing the adults with their times tables knowledge of the 2s, 5s and 10s - definitely needing to be 'Work Well Bears' to secure these skills.

Our site manager, Mr Edbrooke, had the challenging task of selecting the winners from our Friends of School colouring competition. Well done to the following: Albie (Giraffe); Max (Zebra); Ivy (Penguin); Anna (Lion); Megan (Dolphin, and James (Leopard) - your designs were fabulous. Thank you also to families for making suggestions to support our 'Friends of School' and to you all for supporting and helping run events. They make such a difference to the experiences we are able to offer our children with such tight school budgets.

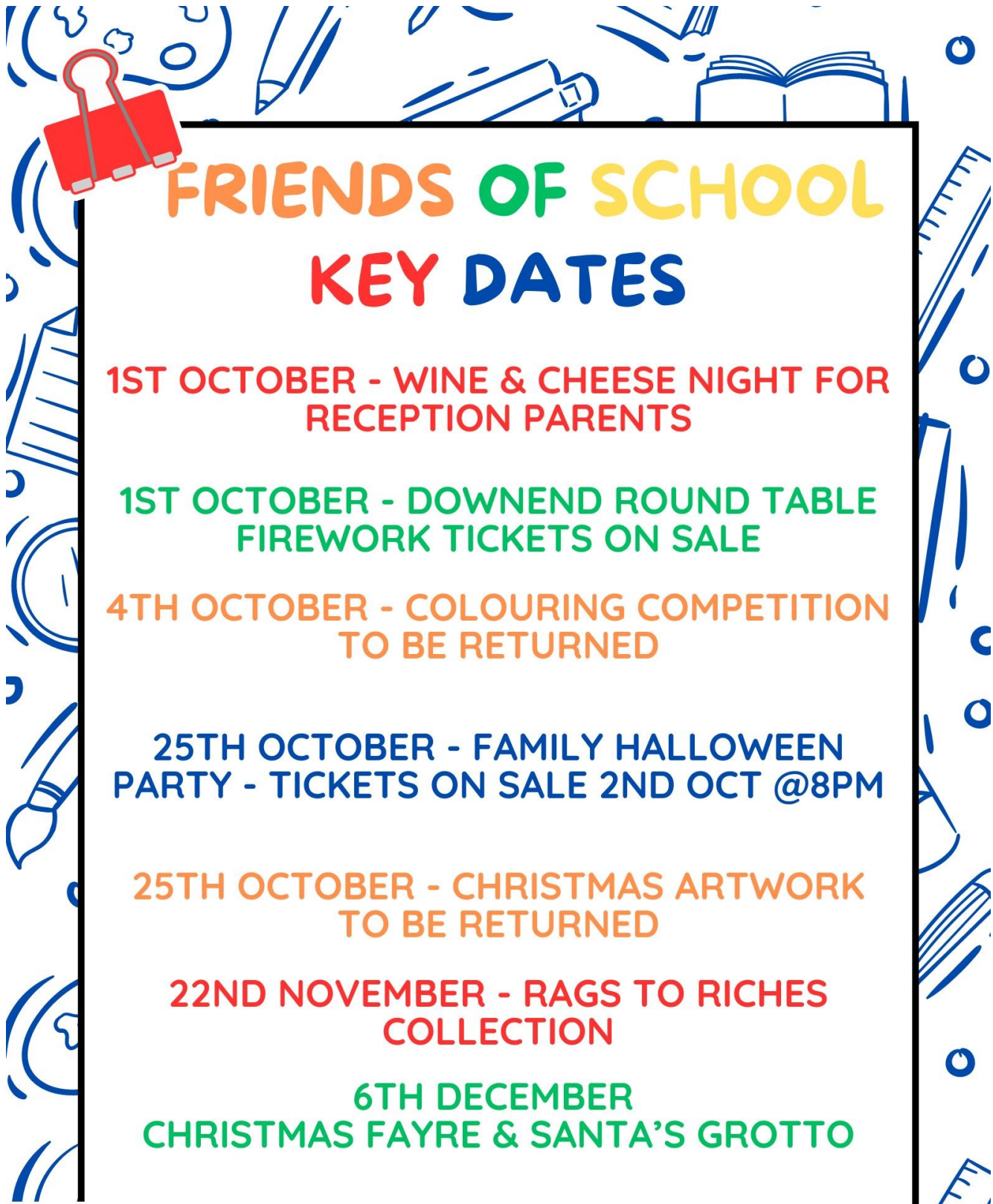
