



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update

This week, we have been focusing on our 'Imagine Bear', encouraging the children to 'think of lots of ideas and follow them to see where they go'. To be a successful 'Imagine Bear', we have been talking to the children about thinking, creating and doing lots. Our top tips to them for being a great 'Imagine Bear' are to 'share your ideas; use and improve other people's and to 'learn from happy mistakes - your idea might go in a different direction'.

This week, our EYFS have started blending sounds and are really looking forward to showing their parents what they have learnt this afternoon. In year one, the children have been listening to stories with autumn themes and completed very imaginative play projects based on autumn, including using mixed media to produce collages; building hedgehog homes for hibernation, and autumn scavenger hunts. I was very impressed by some of their sentence writing around the books read and by their maps, as part of our theme 'Where am I?', depicting our local area. In year two, the children have been innovating the story of 'The Bear and the Piano', and are really proud of the writing they have produced. Both year groups have continued with sketching: in year one, creating beautiful observational drawings of shells and pinecones and in year two, sketching expressions (ask your child to draw one and guess the emotion - it was great fun!) before illustrating their own concertina picture books, based on the stories they had written in English. EYFS have also started on their art journey with self-portraits.

In assemblies, we have been thinking about 'democracy' recently, reading 'If I were prime minister' and considering how through change, the world around us can improve.

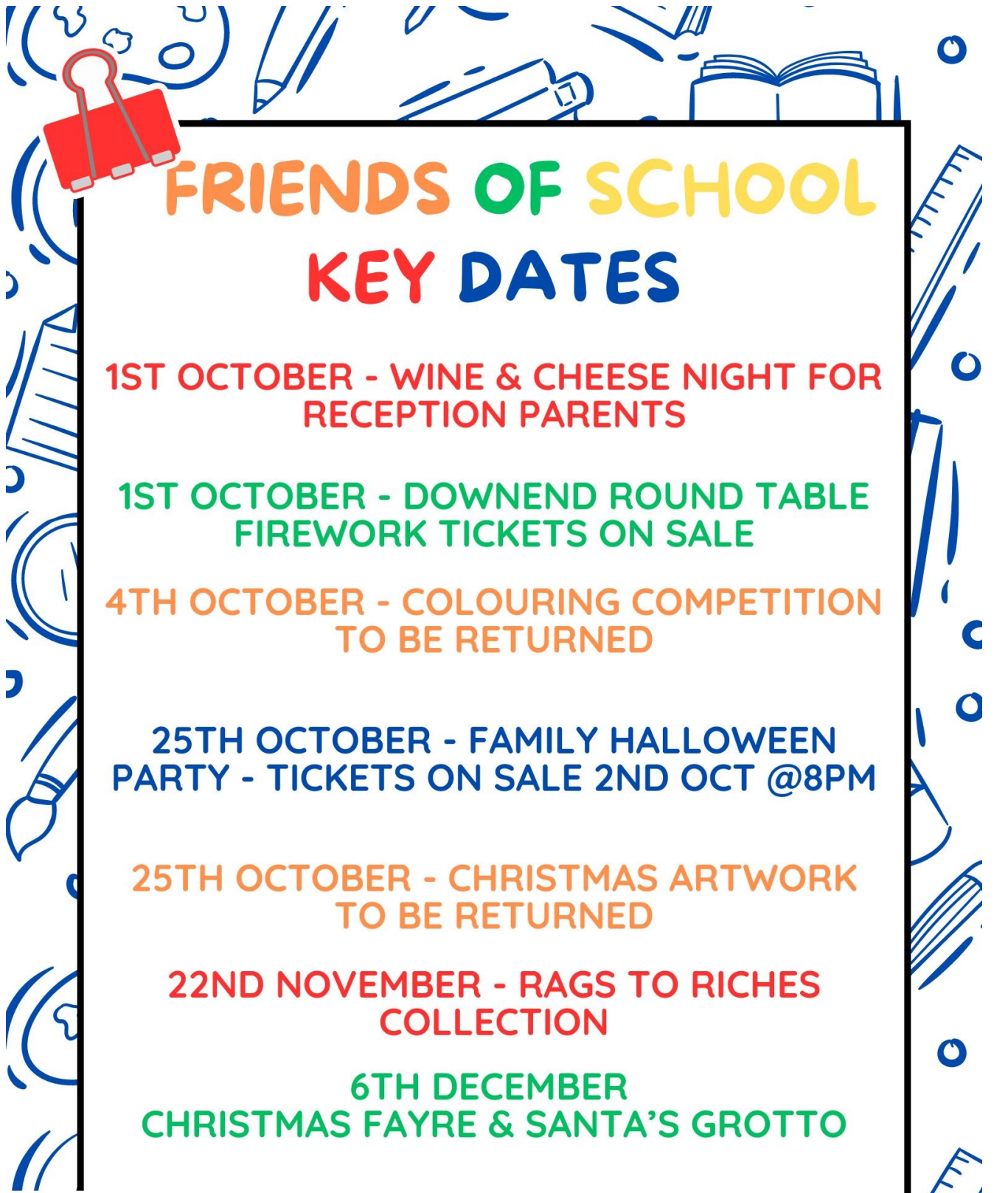
