Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update

This week, in EYFS, we have been thinking about people who help us. Thank you so much to the parents who gave up their time to talk to the children about being a doctor, nurse, fitness instructor and construction manager. The children loved your visits (as did the adults); you inspired brilliant play projects - helped also by having learnt about how to design a successful project - and perhaps future careers!

Our curriculum theme this term is 'Cracking Inventions', which in year one involves learning about space and space travel. This week, they wrote fantastic fact-files about the astronaut, Mae Jemison, and instructions for how to become an astronaut. In their computing lessons, they were real 'Imagine Bears' designing rockets using the 'sketchpad' app. Year two have shown what great 'Challenge Yourself Bears' they are, having learnt division techniques this week for the first time. They also continued their science learning testing to see whether changes in materials are reversible or irreversible, and designed a toy vehicle in D and T. Their enthusiasm for science (as well as design), especially when wearing their lab coats, is fantastic - I am sure that we have some future scientists and engineers among us.

Year one and two loved performing the 'Time to Shine' to families this week. We hope that you enjoyed seeing their learning in action!
