**Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update**

We have had another brilliant week in our 'What a Wonderful World' term. In EYFS, the children presented their learning to families from this term: the children presented shark (as well as fish and mammal) information through the use of oracy maps; sang songs and danced like sea creatures; showed their ocean art work (great water colour skills), and just generally what fantastic learners they are. Today, EYFS have been helping our world be wonderful, a little closer to home, with class trips to the park for litter picking. Thank you Giraffes and Zebras for helping keep Bromley Heath tidy and safe.

Following their zoo trip, year ones have been learning about carnivores, herbivores and omnivores, and in DT have been making moving mechanisms (sliders and levers). They have also really been impressing us with the development of their writing, showcased in letters from Hattie Peck to Percy Pig. Year two have developed their knowledge of habitats by investigating micro-habitats in the school environment. Linking to habitats, and inspired by 'The Last Wolf', their writing as the character of the wolf has been fantastic. In both year groups, a focus on handwriting has really paid off - by developing a fluent ability, children can then focus more on the content of their writing and we have seen creative vocabulary and the use of conjunctions to extend sentences throughout.
