This week, they have read books about recycling; about damage to the ocean from plastic bags, and about the inspirational David Attenborough. Their play projects have been magnificent: classifying, sorting and re-using materials, and creating new objects through recycling. Inspired by David Attenborough, they wrote stories and books about their favourite animals. Following their litter picking at the park last week, they have also been brilliant at lunchtime - helping to find and pick any litter that has blown into the school using the special grabbers. Thank you EYFS!

Fittingly, as penguins and lions, year one have been comparing weather in the UK, with extreme weather in hot and cold places, locating these on maps and considering where the equator is. Like EYFS, next week they will be thinking about human responsibilities to the planet and learning about the impact of global warming on polar ice caps, including on wildlife there.

Year two have continued their learning from year one and been considering the effects of deforestation and changes to habitats, which impact the wildlife there. I was very impressed to hear Dolphins talking about the benefits of trees in terms of habitats, but also oxygen for the world. Both year two classes have been working really hard on their stories, inspired by 'The Last Wolf', focusing on an animal of their choice. I was wowed by their adventurous vocabulary.
