



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update

In EYFS this week, the children have been learning all about different animals' life cycles: butterflies, humans, frogs and chickens - having watched tadpoles grow from frogspawn, it was great to use this experience as a starting point. Thank you to Mrs Fennell for bringing the visitors for their stay in Giraffe class. Their book club this week has also all been frog and tadpole based, securing this understanding.

In year one, the children's learning has been based around 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. In both English and science, they have been working on prediction skills, using what they know to support their thinking: predicting what will happen next in the story and after planting their sunflowers last week, predicting how tall they will grow. Soon, they will be measuring the growth and checking if their predictions were accurate. In their book club this week, they have read various versions of the story, including a surprising one about a baked bean stalk.

Year two have continued stitching their fabric birds in DT (thank you again to all our amazing helpers!) and learnt to use perspective and vanishing point techniques in art; techniques they will apply in painting over the next few weeks. This is a difficult skill and they had to be real 'Improve Bears' to master it (as well as sewing skills). In English, they have been innovating the story of 'Lila and the Secrets of Rain', writing their own versions about the secret of the sun and have also been excellent 'Keep Going Bears' in completing their first reading quiz.
