**Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update**

Our 'Looking back, looking forwards' term is a busy one! This week, in EYFS, the children have continued their dinosaur learning to find out facts about diplodocus and have started learning about what fossils can tell us. In their play projects, they have built dinosaur worlds and created dinosaurs, joining limbs with split pins so that they can move, and created models of volcanoes with dramatic lava. We are very proud as the school nurse came to BHI for the reception checks and commented that they were the best behaved children she has visited! Well done Giraffe and Zebra.

This week, year one have continued their learning all about Alex and the Dragon, writing brilliant instructions on how to make a dragon fly. The examples I read were very specific and included points not only to fly the dragon successfully, but to encourage and reward him. What great 'Understand Others Bears'! In history, they have continued learning about the local area: they discovered that the famous cricketer W.G Grace lived here and played cricket in Downend. They also found out about the Quakers; about their connection with Fry's chocolate, and spotted that our school is on Quaker's Road!

In year two, the children have continued learning about the history of Bristol, this week focusing on Brunel: they found out about his early life and about some of his famous achievements. In art, following on from making clay Norbots last term, and pinch pots in year one, the children made pots of their own design, adding features using a score and slip method to join and seal the clay together. They were ambitious in their designs, which included a Koala and a unicorn!
