Further congratulations to Finn, who won the egg and spoon; Dolphin relay who took bronze, and Aubrey who made the sprint final.

Today, we had a special assembly to celebrate sporting success with our bear certificates and children sharing out-of-school sporting awards to inspire us all. As ever a HUGE thank you to Mrs Warren who calmly organises it all and to families who came to support so enthusiastically.
