

Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update

Term 6 theme: 'Looking forwards, looking back'

Our EYFS have been learning about habitats that dinosaurs might live in, this week thinking about what makes an island and where they are. In play projects, they then built maps of the world, showing islands, and made collages of island landscapes. As we are an island, they also found out about different flags of the UK, before making their own versions, and built models of the UK. They then recapped on triceratops, making hats to make themselves look like one; drew step by step versions, and built habitats for them to live successfully in. I loved hearing their dinosaur raps when I was in EYFS this week, complete with actions!

The medieval topic has continued in year one, with children writing information texts full of facts about medieval castle kitchens; tournaments and knights. Their writing really shows the great progress they have made. Penguin class also visited Vintage Adventure, with a theme around beach holidays: the children shared songs with the elderly residents of Bromley Heath and they talked to each other about holidays - comparing their holidays with ones the children have now, comparing similarities and differences. The children currently in Lion class will visit Vintage Adventure next term when in year two.

In year two, the children have continued thinking about Brunel, sequencing all the events they have learnt on a timeline. Linked to their end of year two production - 'The Bee Musical' - the children have written fantastic non-fiction pieces about bees (as well as beginning rehearsals).

In both year one and two, the children have also started thinking about 'Looking Forwards' into next year: year two had their first session at BHJ and year one a teddy bears picnic in their new classes. Next week, all classes will be involved in transition to their new classes for September (for current EYFS - please see separate letter).
