**Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update**

To start our 'Looking back, looking forwards' term, our EYFS have been looking back a very long way and this week have been focused on dinosaurs! They have learnt all about what dinosaurs were and then individual types, including triceratops and tyrannosaurus-rex. Their books club and play projects have all been dinosaur related: they have created fantastic collages; used junk-modelling to create dinosaurs, and built dinosaur worlds! I was extremely impressed to see children using their sounds to spell out some very tricky dinosaur names! Amazing work EYFS.

In year one, the children have looked at local maps from different times in history to see how the area has changed. They have also enjoyed the story 'Alex and the Dragon', using role-play to act out the plot and thinking of sentences that the characters might say or how they might feel at certain points. Their 'Mission tin' tasks have been challenging them to link sentences together with 'and' or 'because'. Year two have been learning about Bristol history and a time when pirates operated from Bristol and over the seas. In more forward thinking, they have been learning to use stop-animation to make their own short films based in Space, using objects and backgrounds which they had created. Perhaps we have some future Aard-man creatives amongst us!
