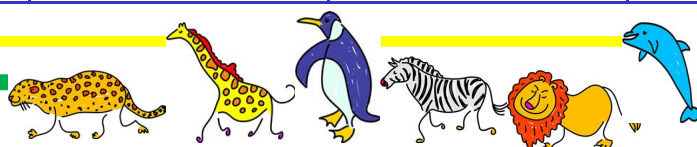

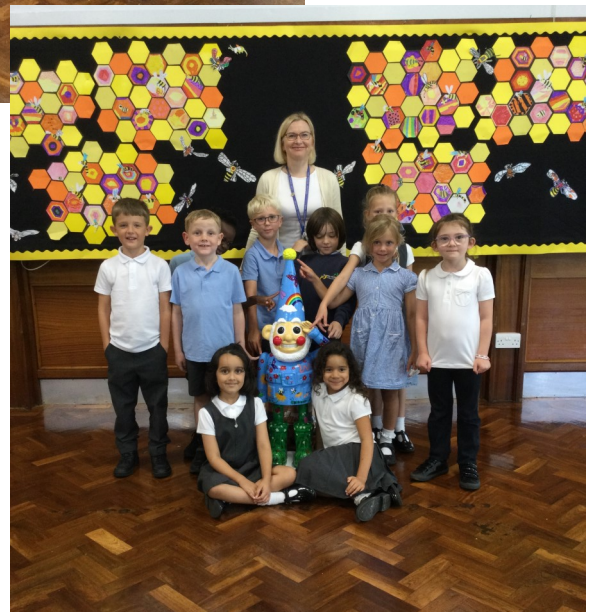

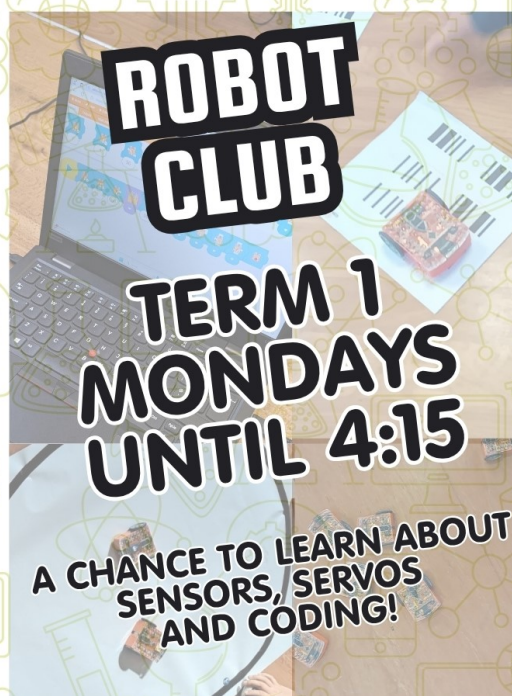


Children spotting parts of their Norbot design in the finished sculpture. Can your year one and two children spot a section of their design on 'The Glorious Gardener'?

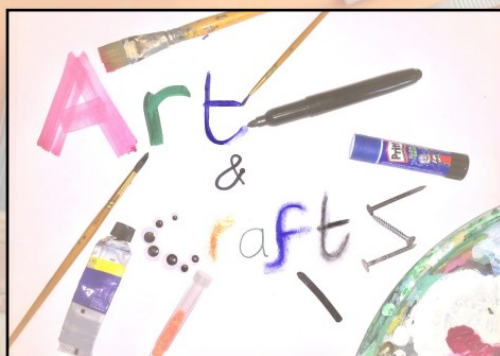
