



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update: T1 theme 'Where am I?'

This week at BHI, we have been concentrating on our 'Improve Bear', advising children that 'great things come from small changes'. We talk to the children about taking their time and doing their best as well as looking back at their work and making it even better in small steps.

Each week, EYFS and year one take part in book club: they read four stories or books from Monday to Thursday, which share a theme or an author. On Friday, the children then discuss their favourites and are encouraged to make connections between the books. In EYFS this week, the children listened to stories by Julia Donaldson and as part of Black History month, year ones listened to a range of non-fiction books celebrating the contributions of Marcus Rashford, Aretha Franklin, Rosa Parks, Ghandi and Martin Luther-King. Ask your children which book was their favourite or which won the vote! In their 'Adventure Quest' this week, year one were inspired by 'The Wonder' by Faye Hanson, writing some fantastic, creative sentences. In year two, after researching St Lucia, the children wrote their own non-fiction files, exploring different aspects of the island. Throughout the school, we encourage children to improve their work - whether EYFS correcting words with magnetic tiles in the Fred room or year two editing their fact files.

In year one and two, the children enjoyed a brilliantly creative afternoon making their own hats ready for their hat cat-walk show today. We hope that families enjoyed the show as much as the children enjoyed making the hats. Following this, the children held a cake sale to raise funds for 'The Grand Appeal'. This is a charity close to our hearts as there are BHI pupils, both past and present, who have spent significant time at the Children's Hospital. Hats off to families for the fantastic cakes that were sent in this morning - and a very big thank you to all who queued and donated! Well done also to School Council for such fantastic suggestions about how we could raise funds for this important charity and to Mrs Harris for coordinating. The remaining cakes will be sold on Monday after school and any cake tins will be available for collection at the front of the school.

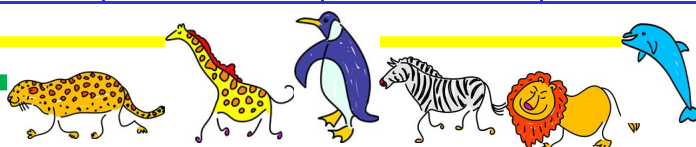

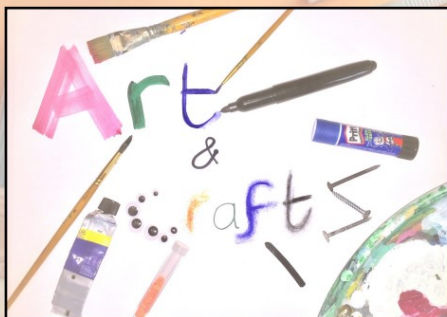
