



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update: T1 theme 'Where am I?'

This week at BHI, we have been concentrating on our 'Work Well Bear': this bear is all about practising to secure a skill. We advise children try their best as lots of effort brings success; to try hard, feel proud and enjoy their work.

This week in EYFS, the children started their Jigsaw (personal, social and health education) lessons: this is a scheme that they will follow until the end of year 6. The children were introduced to the chime, which is a calming way to start the lessons, and to the Jigsaw Charter, which includes the importance of listening to others and allowing everyone to contribute to a discussion, or to opt not to. In these initial lessons, they considered sharing and kindness. The children listened to stories about Diwali, which was also our focus in assembly.

In year one, their 'Adventure Quest' book was 'Christopher Pumpkin', describing settings and characters and writing imaginative potions. In RE, they learnt about the Diwali festival and then in a special play project, made diya lamps; rangoli patterns, and built decorated houses. They also recapped learning about weather and autumn and continued listening to stories about key figures, such as Simone Biles and Ella Fitzgerald as part of Black History. In year two, the children learnt about the contributions of the Windrush generation, as well as some of the struggles that they experienced after arriving in Britain. As a counter-balance to unkind signs that were displayed at the time, the children created their own posters to welcome the arrivals, considering their skills as 'Understand Others Bears'. They also, imagining they were Martin Luther King, wrote letters to the president to request a change in the law to ensure equality for all. In art, they learnt about the Caribbean painter, Bernard Hoyes, and recreated his painting 'Dancing Ladies' beautifully.

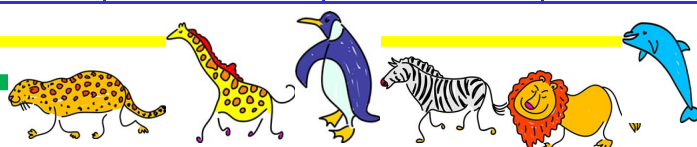

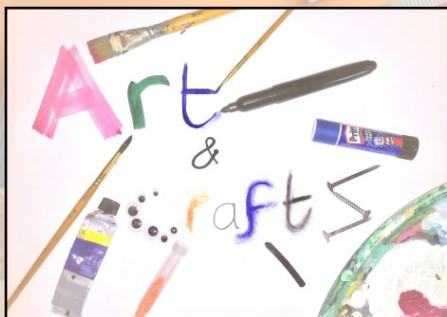
