This week at BHI, we have been thinking about our Keep Going Bear, encouraging children to 'bounce back and try again': we working with the children to think about a different way of trying something; to visualise success and believe in themselves.

Our EYFS have continued to wow us with their fantastic start to school, this week learning about tempo in music using their bodies to demonstrate fast or slow.

In year one, the children have been learning about autumn in science, and enjoying seeing it in action around our grounds; they also produced fantastic self-portraits using shapes, inspired by Paul Klee.

In year two, following on from learning about Bristol in geography, the children have travelled a little further afield in their learning to St Lucia - finding out about different features such as wildlife, climate, housing and location. They will move onto comparing St Lucia to the UK and later in the month, linking to history. In art, they had a fantastic afternoon learning to show different emotions when sketching faces.

Thank you so much for all your harvest festival donations - there was an impressive amount taken to the foodbank. We had a special assembly, considering how small acts of kindness build together to make a big difference; the children really enjoyed listening to the Salvation Army brass band as well as hearing about where the food was going to go. In return, they sang 'Cauliflowers are Fluffy', which sounded lovely. Thank you to Mrs Jenkins for organising.

Finally, a big thank you to Miss Phillips who gave up her time to create raised beds with old tyres, filling them with bulbs for the spring.
