



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update: T2 theme 'Let's Celebrate'

After half term, our EYFS children started 'Drawing Club'. This is an amazing strategy of developing early writing, harnessing children's creativity, alongside separate phonics and handwriting lessons, which develop crucial writing fluency skills. This week, the club was based around 'SuperTato', with their imaginations taking flight drawing and labelling a robot, which could clear up, or a new vegetable, superhero. The classrooms both now have a 'Drawing Club' display, showcasing their work.

In year one, the children have continued with their paper sculpture unit - following on from firework sculptures, which burst out from the classroom displays - scrunching, rolling and joining paper to begin their final piece, based on different trees. In their Jigsaw learning, they have been considering similarities and differences between us all and that neither are barriers to friendship. Their 'Adventure Quest' this week has been based on 'The Big Dreaming', drawing and writing about how the bear could return home and what he could dream about. Amazing 'Imagine Bears'!

It has been a busy week for year two. On Monday morning, they visited the synagogue on Park Street, learning more about symbols and important parts of the synagogue and Jewish faith. On Wednesday, they then designed beautiful stain glass windows, with symbols of Judaism represented to show their understanding. Yesterday, as part of their science learning, they had a visit from 'Jonathan's Jungle Roadshow' so that the children could see up close the features of different animals, building understanding around classification and processes for all living things. They discovered amazing facts and many children bravely faced their fears. Terrific 'Try New Things Bears'! I have also been blown away by their extended writing based on 'The Last Stop on the Reindeer Express' and their recounts of Jonathan's Jungle visit - it is particularly lovely to see the children's pride in their own work and progress.

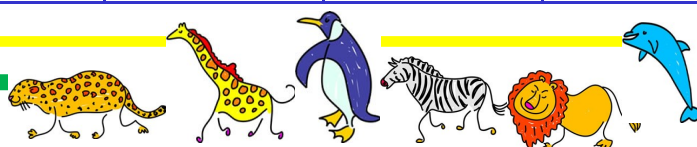

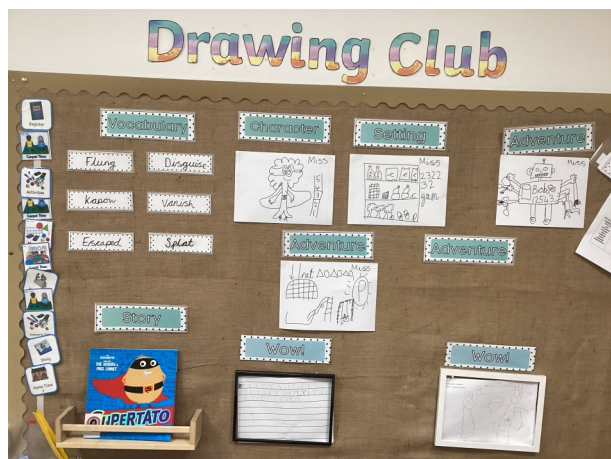

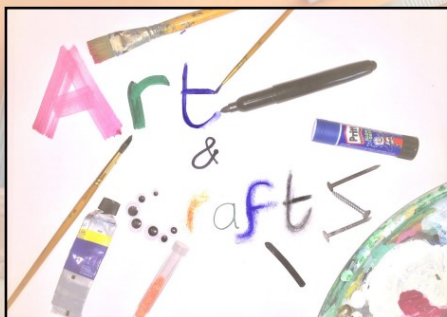
