We hope you enjoyed this opportunity.

Play projects this week have all been book based with the children 'making and creating', drawing, writing or building projects, including of their favourite book character; redesigning their class book corners, and a book themed scavenger hunt. The scavenger hunts were great at helping the children to access different areas of the library and learning where each section is.

Yesterday, the story teller, Paula Brown, visited all classes telling a variety of stories, enlivened by props and by weaving children's ideas into the tales. An inspirational session and many thanks to our amazing FOS for funding. Today, all children read for 60 minutes with a class interactive timer adding the minutes throughout the day. It was lovely to see children sharing and enjoying different books. This was also the final part of the school's 'Readathon' and we are simply blown away by the funds raised to support us in refreshing and redesigning our class book corners - with over £2100 raised (so far!). WOW! Thank you to all family members who donated.

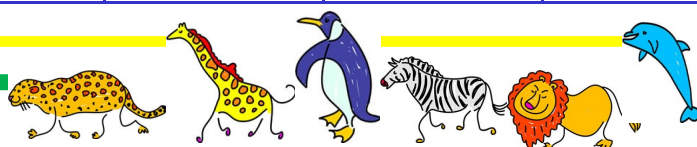

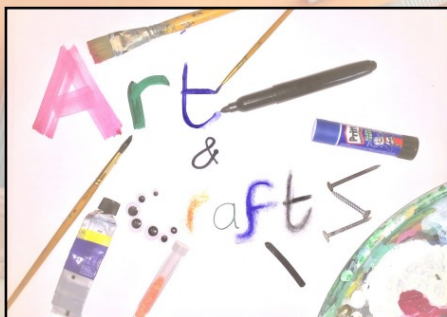
