



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update: T3 theme 'Cracking Ideas'

Inspired by Izzy Gizmo, an inventor extraordinaire, children in EYFS have been creating toolboxes to be like Izzy; inventions for repainting her crow's wings; drawing a plan for their own invention, and have also started using collage as well as paint to create art works. In other art sessions, they enjoyed time in the forest, collecting natural objects and used these as inspiration for different paint textures.

Year one have been inspired by space: reading and writing about their Adventure Quest text 'The Way Back Home', with play projects about space, aliens, scientists and materials. All their book club choices have been themed around stories with a space setting with children comparing the four books and expressing their preferences. Their science learning has centred around materials: naming them and their properties; matching suitable materials to objects, and describing the properties of materials around them.

Our year twos have recapped on their materials learning from year one and furthered their understanding. In reverse, they looked at objects with an unsuitable material for their purpose e.g. a chocolate teapot, and explained why these would not be good designs using their materials' knowledge. Like year one, they are using their key text, 'The Tin Forest', as inspiration for their writing, retelling the story in stages. In their science experiment, they have been investigating which materials would be most suitable for the curtains for the cottage from the story. In RE, they have been listening to parables from the bible and reflecting on what the teaching message is behind these stories.

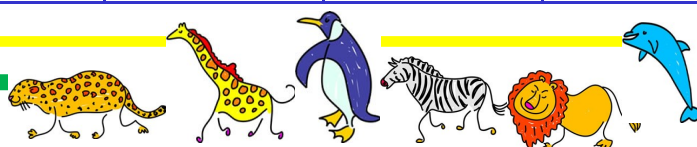

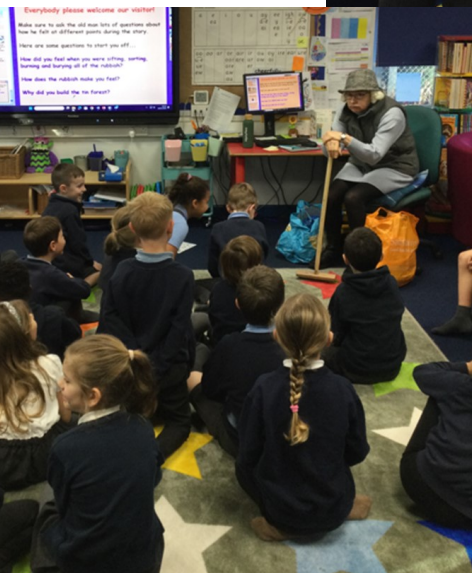
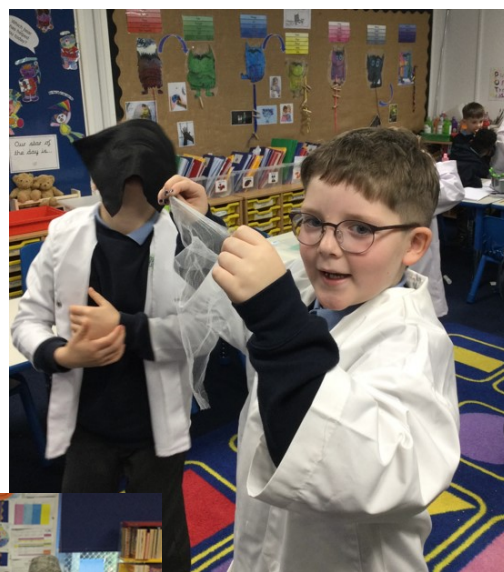


EYFS at forest school and year one learning about materials and space

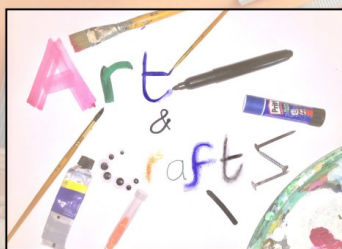
