



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update: T3 theme 'Cracking Ideas'

Yesterday, our Challenge Support partner and two Endeavour heads visited the school to support with our self-evaluation and monitoring, focusing on metacognition. They were very impressed with all aspects of teaching and learning and I felt very proud of all the staff and children.

Our EYFS this week have been learning the story of 'The Three Little Pigs', using this as inspiration for their drawing club and play projects. They thought creatively, showing their ideas through drawing and writing, about tricking the wolf to eat something else or describing what the wolf's disguise could be; in play projects, they made pig hand puppets; built the three houses, and role played the story.

This week in year one, the children have been setting themselves goals in play project time and working hard on planning their projects so that we can achieve their goals. On Thursday, their goal was to create something that could be displayed in a 'Space Museum' at the end of the session, using colour mixing skills to help them create art work and 3D sculptures. The museum was full of amazing creations - ranging from playdough aliens and planets; paintings of the solar system (including salt to add texture and rocks); to impressive models of the International Space Station. It was a brilliant morning.

Year two have been having a lot of fun in D and T and science: in D and T investigating moving vehicle parts (as well as the vehicles) before designing their own vehicle for the old man in 'The Tin Forest' and in science, testing materials to discover which material would be most suitable for his house in order to be waterproof and strong.

A busy but fun week.

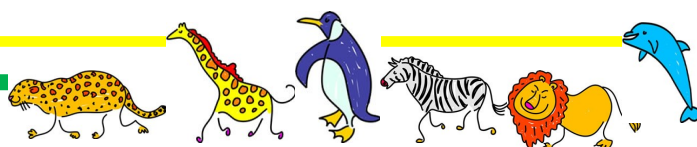

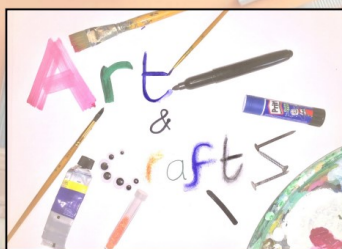
