In art, moving on from drawing to music last week, they worked together to create a flower collage using different materials and created some transient art using natural materials. I was impressed with their collaborative and sharing skills.

Learning has been out of this world in year one, with history based on the Moon landings and play projects about Neil Armstrong (this may explain to parents why some children came home wearing a space helmet). Their English has been based around 'The Man on the Moon (A Day in the Life of Bob)': recounting and retelling the story and writing letters to Bob. They have worked so hard on their writing, including joining sentences with 'and' and asking questions. Terrific 'Concentrate Bears'!

In year two, there has been much excitement this week as all children have designed and made their vehicles to support the old man in his work in 'The Tin Forest'. This involved measuring, sawing; joining wheels and axles, and a great deal of problem solving. They were amazing 'Challenge Yourself Bears'. A massive thank you from Mrs Gregory to the many parents who gave up an afternoon to support. The children loved it - and having so many helpers! Next week, they are going to add the finishing touches in terms of decorative design and evaluate their finished work.

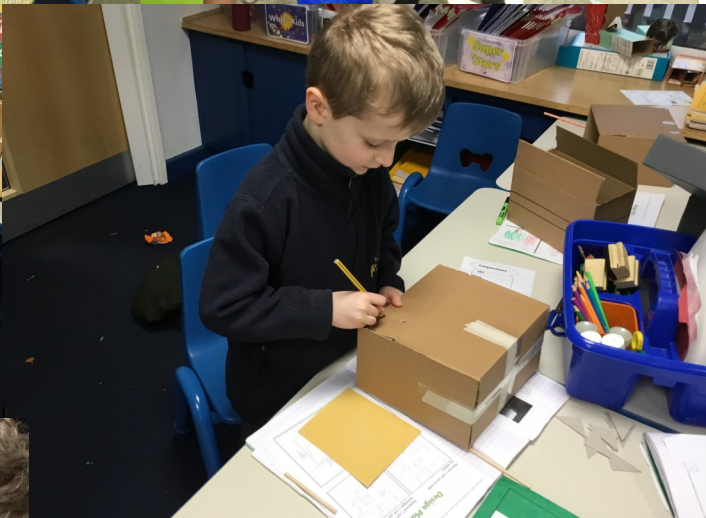

at Bromley Heath Infants



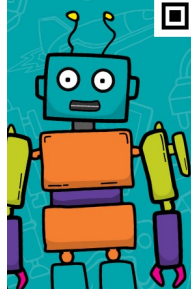
