



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update: T3 theme 'Cracking Ideas'

Happy new year! A chilly but cracking first week back at BHI.

In EYFS, the children are beginning 'Play Projects' and this week they were introduced to the four main areas of our play (make and create, build, draw and message). From next week, they will compete daily play projects (playing while learning and developing at the same time), which will also continue into year one and then weekly but still very popularly, in year two. They have also started their new Oracy sessions, using pictures for discussions points. Most excitingly, Fred the Frog had his fifth birthday today and celebrated with all of EYFS, including making five in different ways; making Fred a birthday card and a collage cake. Mrs Grieve gave the children the option to have their face painted (a talented artist) and they even had a special Phonics disco, with music and sounds to freeze on when the music stopped. Ask your child about their day - they had amazing fun!

Year one were also very excited to start lots of new learning and also revisit some of their previous learning from last term. In science, they recapped knowledge about the seasons and what changes we might be able to see; they wrapped up warm and then went outside and took a picture of what the trees look like in winter. Looking beyond our planet, they then started learning about space linked to their new key text: 'The Way Back Home' by Oliver Jeffers. They loved finding out about the adventures of the boy and the alien, and have created maps through space showing where the boy might have travelled. Year two have also been re-capping science vocabulary to describe materials, thinking about which materials are suitable for ... Like year one, they have been reading their new key text, 'The Tin Forest' by Helen Ward, already using the imaginative language within the story in their own work. The book has provoked thoughtful contributions about the importance of forests and the environment around us.

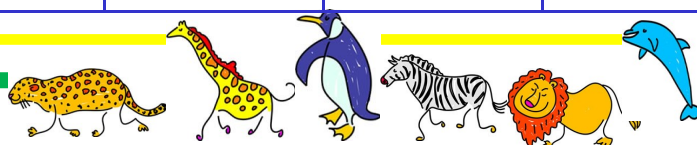

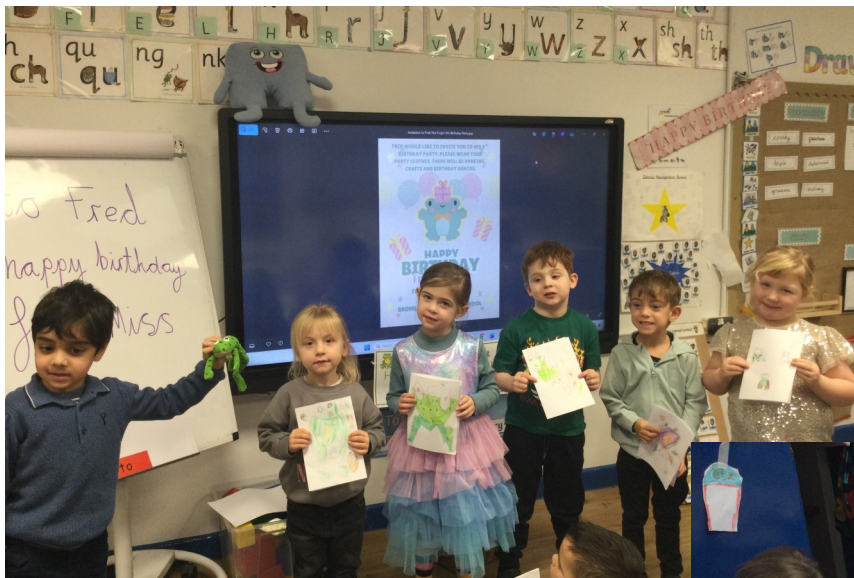

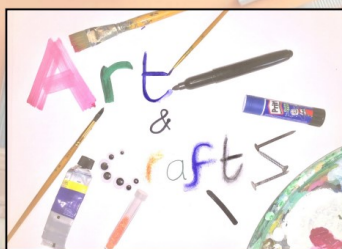
