



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update: T3 theme 'Cracking Ideas'

EYFS have continued learning from visitors this week, who have shared with them how their jobs help the community. They heard from a vet, a haematologist and a nurse (thank you to Miss Phillips, Dr Ball and Mrs Bisp for sharing your time) we also had a visit from a police officer, who talked to them about keeping the community safe and clean (before they had a chance to see the police car up close).

Year one have continued their learning around space with some fantastic writing of fact-files about, and instructions to, Mae Jemison who has also inspired them in their play projects, including creating astronaut backpacks and building the interior of the International Space Station! As well as painting landscapes inspired by Van Gogh, showcasing their colour mixing and tinting skills, they have used ipads to create drawings of rocket designs.

Year two have been working together to create a beautiful, collaborative work of art, now displayed in the corridor (which you will be able to see for yourselves next term at parents' consultations). It is based on 'The Tin Forest': the children created their own collages of animals of plants that might live there using scrap bits of paper and foil. Inspired by their non-fiction key text, 'A Planet Full of Plastic', they have also been thinking about the difficult problem of how to manage materials which do not biodegrade in both science and in their English writing.

This thinking from year two linked to their workshop today from 'Green Up Your Act', with the children considering again re-using materials, this time creating their own 'eco-fish', using recycled 'scales' to create individual works of art. Year one reused materials to make recycled notebooks, again thinking about reducing waste. Thank you to Friends of School for funding: the children loved the workshops and learnt a lot from them in a practical and engaging manner. EYFS have not missed out as there will be further 'Green Up Your Act' workshops later in the year, which they are included in.
