



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update: T3 theme 'Cracking Ideas'

Our science week has been full of wonder, curiosity, investigation and discovery. The additional learning experiences have been both fun and purposeful and in every classroom I have been, there have been classes full of children concentrating, investigating and smiling.

On Monday, our science lead, Miss Lee led a science assembly introducing this year's British science week theme of curiosity. They reflected on what curiosity means and how different scientists (vets and geologists) need to ask questions to be successful in their roles. The Explorer Dome arrived on Tuesday and Wednesday, with all classes enjoying an interactive, multi-sensory science show: for EYFS, this was based around the environment, revisited and expanded in year two, and in year one, they learnt about the human body. Children loved the dome - thank you to our Friends of School for funding: we could not recreate this learning in the classroom e.g. in year two, dry ice was used to simulate Antarctica; glowing lights in the dark demonstrated animals that produce bioluminescence in the rainforest with 'rain' changing the atmosphere, and the 'landfill' smell also added to the understanding from visuals used! Yesterday, the children all took part in fantastic, practical online workshops from 'Inventors and Makers': EYFS considered ways to save energy; year one learnt about stable structures and in groups were challenged to create a bridge that would hold a weight, and in year two, they again thought about energy and how this can be produced, before creating their own wind turbines.

Today, the children - with many families also taking part - produced a project based around something that moved, changed; solved a problem, or showed a science idea. We were tremendously impressed by the children's (and families'!) ideas, including balloon powered cars; colour mixing through food dye travelling along tissue; marble runs; hot air balloons ... and a myriad of other highly inventive ideas. Brilliant 'Imagine Bears'! Thank you all for your time and support and a HUGE thank you to Miss Lee for planning such a brilliant and memorable week.

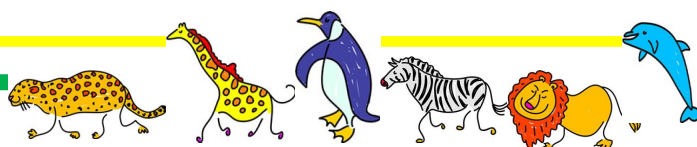

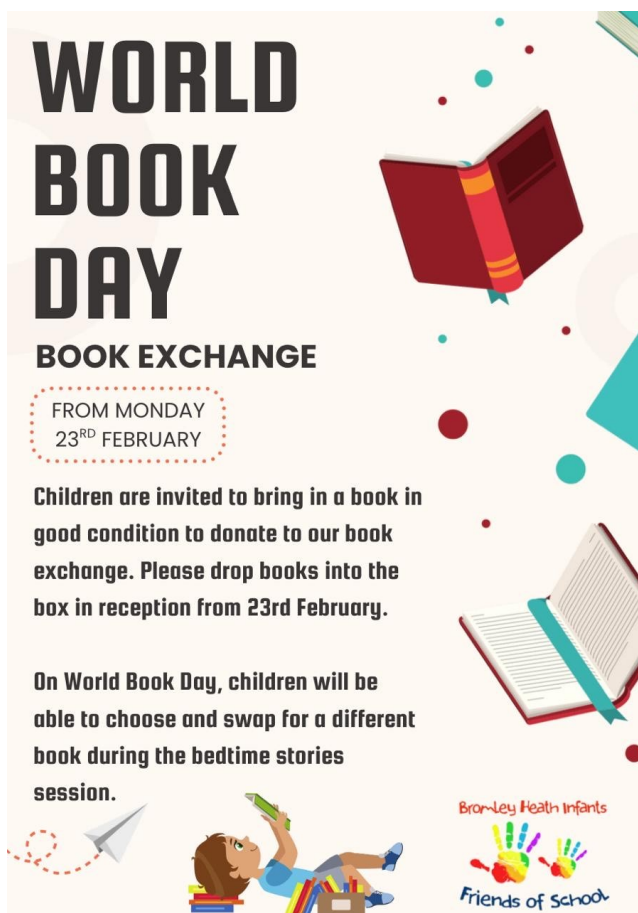

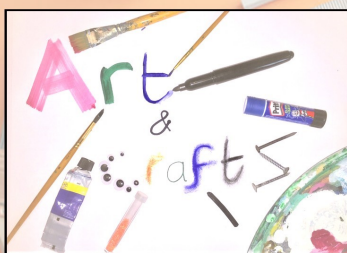

Have fun, get creative and use a wide range of materials to make, draw and paint a range of craft projects.

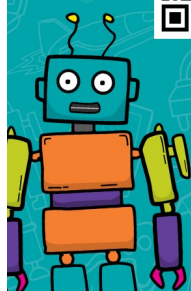
