



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update: T3 theme 'Cracking Ideas'

This week, EYFS have been learning about the emergency services and people that help us. They have learnt about dentists; the fire service; road safety, and loved hearing from visitors about their work in the community. Thank you to Mrs Gill, who spoke about neo-natal nursing, and to Mrs Mitchell, who spoke about her work as a midwife - the children (and adults) were very impressed! If anybody else could give up some time to talk to the children about this topic, please let the EYFS team know.

Year one have continued with their learning about space, focusing on the astronaut Mae Jemison: her dreams, resilience and achievements, writing both about her aspirations as a child and their own hopes for the future. Today, during their 'Time to Shine', the children loved designing and creating their own rockets, showcasing their learning with families - definitely rising to the challenge set in their morning space briefing.

Year two also impressed this afternoon with their 'Time to Shine', singing 'Hands, Feet and Heart' with a glockenspiel accompaniment, and sharing their moving vehicles and 'Talk for Writing' shared text with families. By learning words and actions to a text, children are supported in learning sentence construction, punctuation and text organisation - a huge well done to all of Y2 as there was a lot to remember! Great 'Concentrate Bears'.

This week, I have been in all classes looking at writing and have been delighted to see the enthusiasm in every class to produce their best: from EYFS to Y2, children independently access sound mats and challenge themselves to use adventurous vocabulary, often inspired by their key texts. We have worked hard over the last two years on strategies to further improve children's handwriting as fluency in this area frees up cognitive space to focus on composition, punctuation and spelling so it was also lovely to see the pride that children are taking in the presentation of their work.

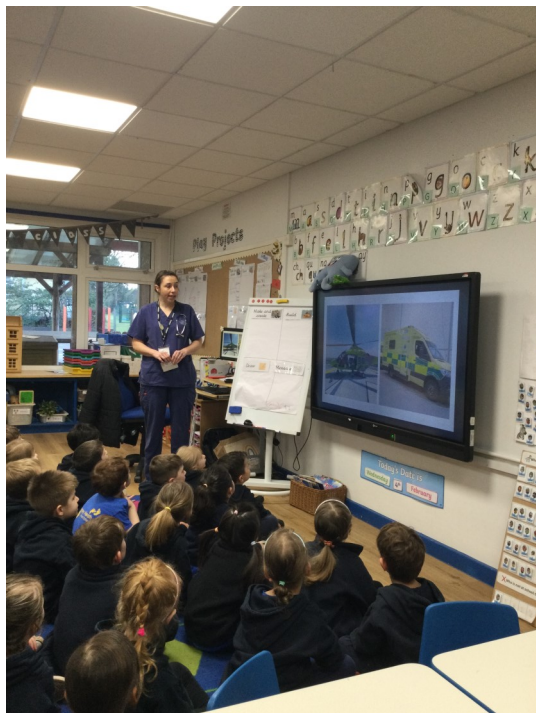

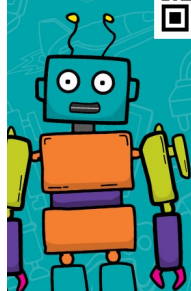
Have fun, get creative and use a wide range of materials to make, draw and paint a range of craft projects.
