



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update: T4 theme 'What a Wonderful World'

In EYFS this week, the children have been learning all about different types of whales and sharks, including features of fish and mammals, appearance and size. They have created 'oracy' maps to support recall of key information; made collages or models; built habitats; written fact-files and surveyed their friends to tally their favourites. Impressive work Zebras and Giraffes - and best of all, you have all been all smiles, just like 'Smiley Shark'.

Yesterday, following their learning about different classes of animals, year one had a great time at Noah's Ark Zoo farm seeing some of this knowledge in action. They had an opportunity to tour the zoo and see the different types of animal there, reading the information, and taking part in a workshop, which included close-up encounters with a snake and a giant African land snail. I don't think I have ever given out so many headteacher stickers in one day as I have today reading their amazing recounts of the zoo trip. Great scientists and authors year one!

Both EYFS and year one have also loved watching the tadpoles hatch and seeing them grow, with science learning and play projects inspired by them.

In year two, the children have also been learning about animals and their habitats in science, following on from the environment show in the Explorer Dome. They started by learning about features of different habitats and then how different animals are adapted to live successfully in these habitats. In English, their writing has been based on 'The Last Wolf': thinking of sentences using new vocabulary learnt and writing letters from the main character, Little Red.

Last week, deputies from our Endeavour group of schools, visited all classrooms to see RE learning in action: they were very impressed with the children's learning behaviour, understanding and thoughtful contributions. Thank you to Mrs Jenkins for leading this subject with so much care.

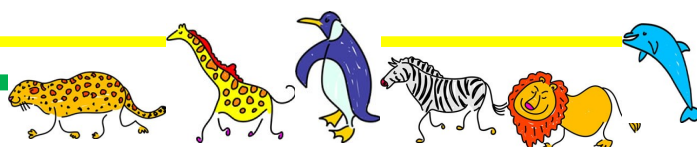

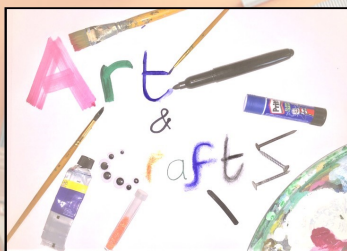

Have fun, get creative and use a wide range of materials to make, draw and paint a range of craft projects.

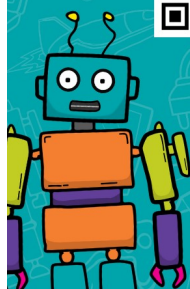
