



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update: T4 theme 'What a Wonderful World'

Ahead of their aquarium trip, learning in EYFS this week has been very much shark focused! They have been learning and writing facts about sharks and in their science lessons, creating oracy maps about hammerhead and great white sharks. In their play projects, they have been focusing on re-using and recycling items to create new items with a different purpose.

In year one, they have started reading Hattie Peck this week: considering the main character; settings, and retelling the story. In science, they have grouped animals into carnivores, herbivores and omnivores and investigated animals 'poo' to find out what they eat. A big thank you to the year fives who returned to BHI, setting up and running infant agility sessions for year one. Penguin and Lion had great fun and were great 'Challenge Yourself Bears' - thank you Otter and Newt classes. It was lovely to see you back at BHI!

In year two, the children have been impressing us all with the progress in their writing - both handwriting and writing composition, with vocabulary and sentence construction becoming much more varied. I hope that you were also impressed during the 'Time to Shine', especially their diary entries as characters from 'The Last Wolf'. In science, they have been investigating how different plants are adapted to their environments, sorting plants into hot, cold and wet habitats. Continuing the plant theme, in art, they have continued to focus on flowers in their work: last week, using oil pastels to create large pieces, zoning in on parts of a flower; this week, having learnt about pointillism, using cotton buds and paint to create vibrant flower paintings. These should be on display in the corridor for parents' consultations. Year two have also been great 'Keep Going Bears' in PE: throwing a ball through moving targets, which is pretty tricky and requires lots of practising! Well done Leopard and Dolphin.

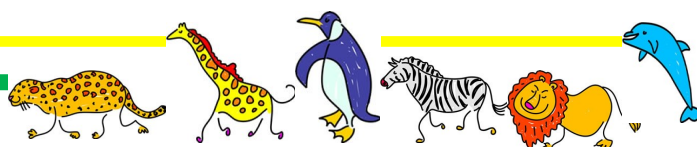

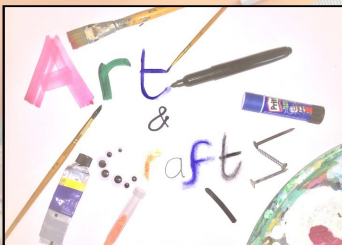

at Bromley Heath Infants



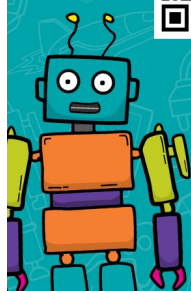
