It has been an exciting week in EYFS - last Friday, they measured out a whale shark and a blue whale on the field, with every child spaced out to replicate the shape and scale of the creatures, which was then captured with an aerial photograph. It gave the children a great impression of just how big these amazing animals are. They have been extremely busy with countless ocean-themed creations, whether water colour paintings, or play projects, considering how we can take care of the oceans. Today, they loved their trip to Bristol aquarium: I have been told that the best bits were seeing the giant fish; sharks; rays ... and 'everything'.

Like EYFS, in year one, the children have also been considering human responsibilities to our world environment, including learning about polar ice caps and the impact of these melting. Their enthusiasm for writing is brilliant and I have been tremendously impressed with their stories based on Hattie Peck - the vivid vocabulary they included was a delight. Thank you Penguin and Lions for sharing your stories with me.

Again in year two this week, their writing has really taken off with terrific story writing, innovating 'The Last Wolf'. It has been lovely reading so many exceptional pieces of work - filled with imaginative and adventurous vocabulary, and seeing the pride that the children are taking in their work.

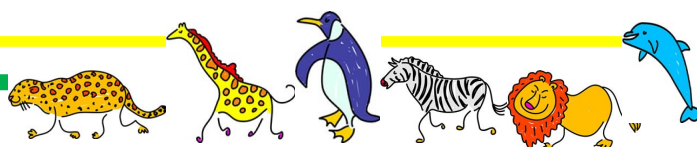

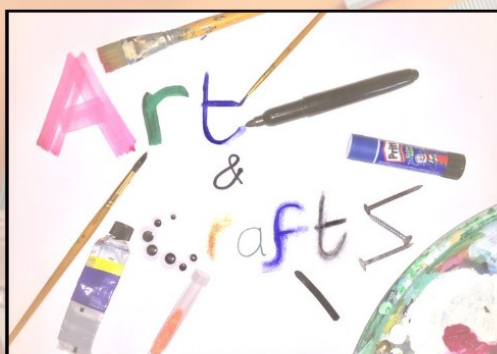

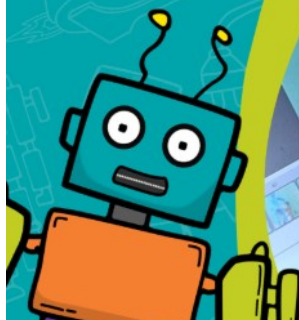
