

Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update: T5 theme 'What's at the Bottom of the Garden?'



We have had a lovely, sunny and bright week back at school and are all loving this term's theme already - especially as it means extra time outside! Our EYFS children have been making the most of the newly revamped outdoor area, enthusiastically exploring and learning through play. From creating mud pies to building cars and dens in the construction zone, their imaginations have truly been thriving. They thoroughly enjoyed their litter-picking trips, revisiting last term's learning about caring for our world. Along the way, the children spotted a variety of plants, linking beautifully to their new focus. As ever, we were very proud of their behaviour and they loved spending time in the park after their good work cleaning up the park.

In year one, the children started thinking about garden plants through their text 'Katie and the Sunflower' before two nature walks on the field: the first spotting signs of spring and the second identifying different plants and flowers growing in different habitats. In science, they then investigated the structure of plants, including by dissecting flowers and by careful observation. Year twos revisited their science learning from year one, recalling parts of plants, and then began investigations into whether all seeds germinate in the same way. Having set up their experiments, they will be observing and measuring carefully over the next few weeks to answer their scientific questions. Like year one, their book is linked and I was delighted with the work they shared with me based on 'Lila and the Secrets of Rain'. I am very proud year two!

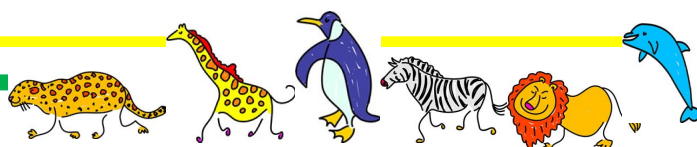

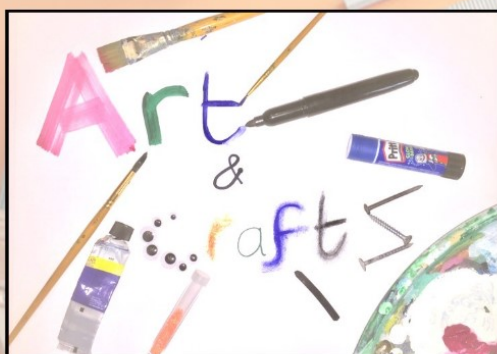

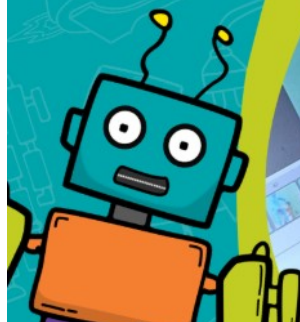
