To start our work about Blackbeard – the pirate from Bristol the children can come to school **dressed as a pirate** on **Thursday 4th June**.

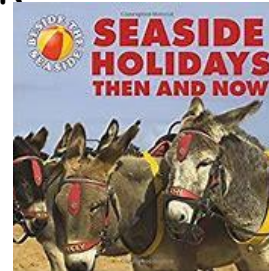
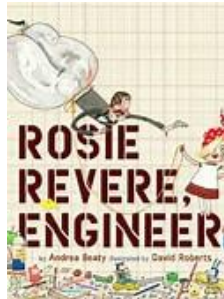
PE

Looking Forward, Looking Back



History

We will be learning about the history of Bristol, the characters who shaped the landscape, and the reasons why the city has the landmarks it has. We will learn how the work of Brunel changed the ways in which people travelled and the effect this had on the landscape of seaside towns such as Weston Super Mare.

RE
