



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update: T5 theme 'What's at the Bottom of the Garden?'

In EYFS, the children have continued their science learning discovering more about the parts of a plant. In play projects, they have drawn and labelled life cycles of a plant; the parts of a plant and what they need to grow. They are fast becoming experts! They are also loving their new outdoor area - thank you to Mrs Church for the additional mud kitchen and to Bristol Artificial Grass Company for some extra sections of astro turf. It is a joy to see them extending their play and learning in this renewed space.

Following on from learning about parts of a flower, year one have been considering what a plant needs to grow in science before planting sunflower seeds themselves. In their 'Adventure Quest', after reading 'From Seed to Sunflower' and after their own planting, they wrote precise instructions about how to plant a seed - very helpful for any gardener!

In year two, the children have also been investigating with plants in science. Having taught in year two this afternoon, I can say how impressed I was with their understanding of what a scientist does, including setting up investigations and then measuring carefully; observing and wondering, and research. Today, following setting up an investigation about germination last week (and measuring week two today), they set up their second investigation to test plant growth in different temperatures. They have also been working hard on their reading detective skills this week and have started learning sewing skills, practising sewing in different patterns; skills, which will later in the term be applied to a DT project.

On Wednesday, all classes enjoyed an additional PE lesson with a visiting sports coach delivering a golf lesson. Thank you to Mrs Warren for organising - the children really enjoyed it and it was a great opportunity to try a new sport. A very busy week!

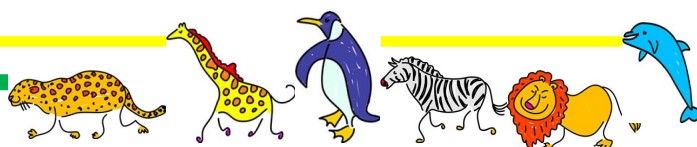

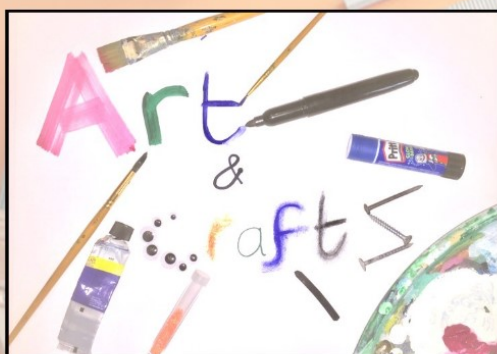

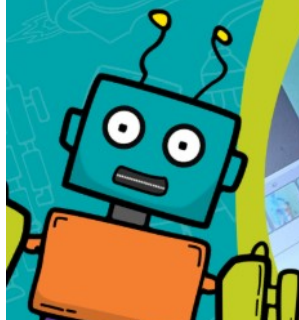
