



Mrs Perry-Hodge's weekly update: T5 theme 'Looking Back, Looking Forward'

Welcome back to the last term of our year! It is a busy one, not just in school but with trips and with multiple Friends of School events: please do look at the dates for these.

In EYFS this week, the children have been looking a long way back ... their key text is 'Tom and the Island of the Dinosaurs' and it has really sparked their interest, inspiring a very busy and productive week learning all about dinosaurs, fossils and volcanoes. In writing, and inspired by dinosaurs, they have been moving on from dictated sentences and are challenging themselves to extend their sentence all by themselves. We are truly impressed with their writing - well done Zebra and Giraffe.

In year one, their writing is also a highlight. They have been inspired by 'Alex and the Dragon' in their adventure quests, writing character descriptions as well as deciding whether they want to be Alex's friend or not using 'because' to explain their thinking (with ideas such as - 'yes because he is courageous and imaginative' or 'no because he is too risky with his inventions'). In history, they have began learning about the local area and how it has changed over the last 100 years, comparing past and present maps and photographs.

Year twos have also been looking back - to Bristol 400 years ago, including learning about pirates (your children should be able to tell you some very strange facts about Blackbeard!) All the adults have also been very impressed with their concentration in their recent reading quizzes and in how carefully the children have worked to find the answers in the text.

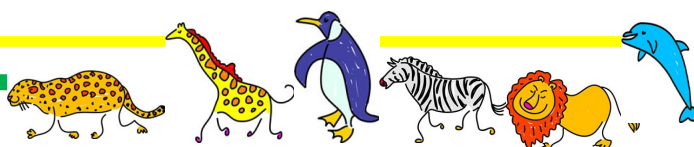

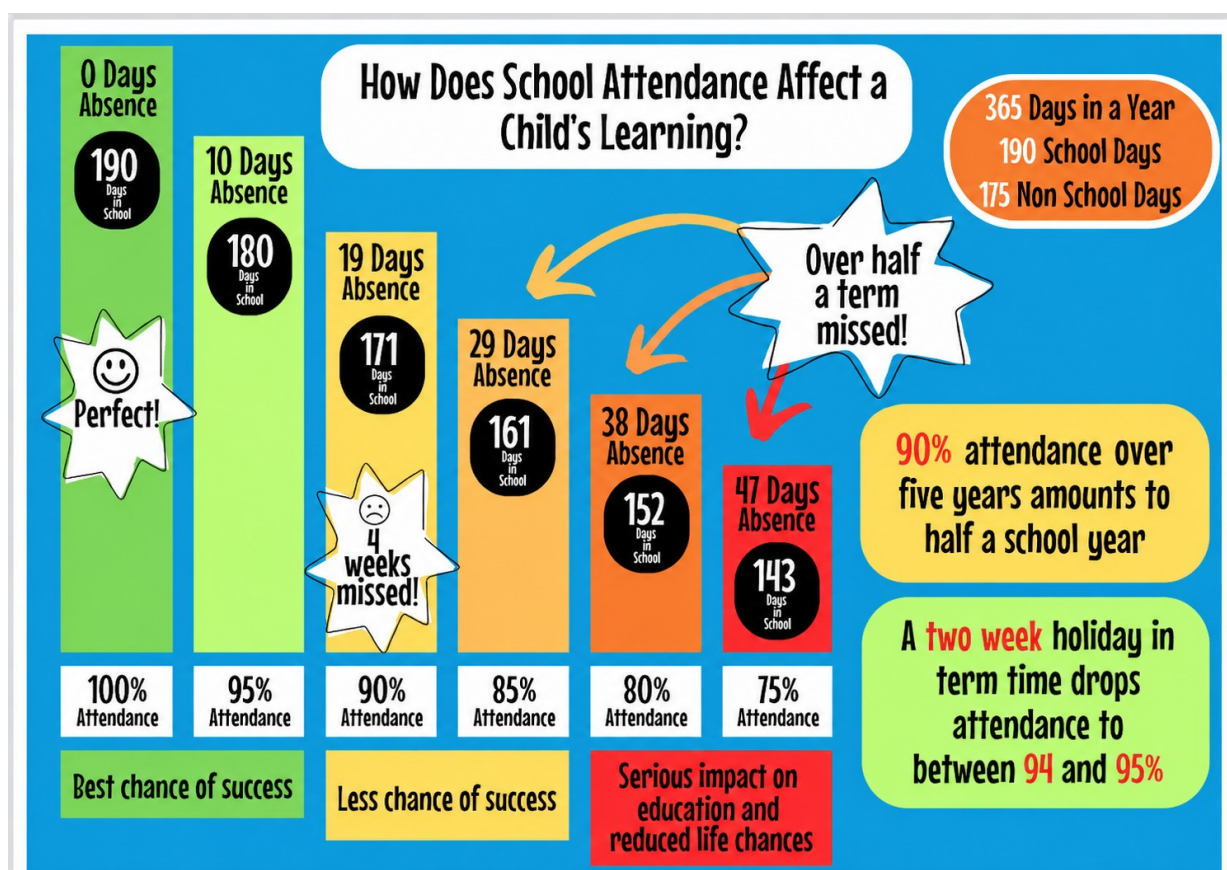

ACING ATTENDANCE!

Attendance is a significant national, education priority as rates of attendance still remain below pandemic numbers. Whilst attendance at BHI is generally good, we are noticing increasing numbers of term time holiday requests. For your information, attached is the local authority penalty notice information for families - this applies from five days of term time holiday within a ten week period (so from a week's holiday).

Some absence is unavoidable, including exceptional leave and illness (and we fully appreciate these incidences and are aware of individual children's situations); however, as ask that you avoid term time leave wherever possible as there is an impact on children's education from missed days and weeks in school. As an infant school, much of the learning is foundational and therefore important for future learning - and whilst our curriculum is carefully planned and sequenced, including 'loops of learning' to revisit key points, we cannot always recap learning from absences. The DFE's research shows a strong correlation between attendance in these early years and GCSE outcomes so whilst the children are young, their attendance has both short and long term impacts. Below illustrates how this adds up.
