It has been a great start to term. Giraffe and Zebra classes have shown great readiness for school and have all been amazing 'Try New Things' bears. We are all very impressed with their first week - a BIG well done to them all!; once they are in are full time, their classes will also be included in certificates below.

In this first term, we are focusing each week on a different bear to develop children's understanding about what each bear (learning attribute) means. NO NUTS NO SESAME SEEDS



Thank you for your help
in keeping all children
safe.

A reminder that we have children with nut and sesame allergies in school (in different classes and year groups), for whom exposure to nuts and sesame has serious consequences. Please do not send nuts or sesame seeds into school or any product containing them. For clarity, this is all nuts, including peanuts, almonds, brazil nuts, cashews, cashews, hazelnuts, macadamia, pecans, pistachios, walnuts and chestnuts. Pine nuts and sesame seeds, whilst both seeds, cause the same reaction as nuts and so are also included as foods that cannot come into school.

We ask that you check all packaging carefully for any snacks/ packed lunches so that products containing any nuts, pine nuts or sesame seeds do not make their way in. It is not possible to name all products containing nuts, pine nuts or sesame, but in particular, please note that chocolate spread generally contains nuts; breadsticks or rolls often contain sesame seeds; hummus contains sesame seeds (as paste - tahini), and pesto generally contains pine nuts or cashews.

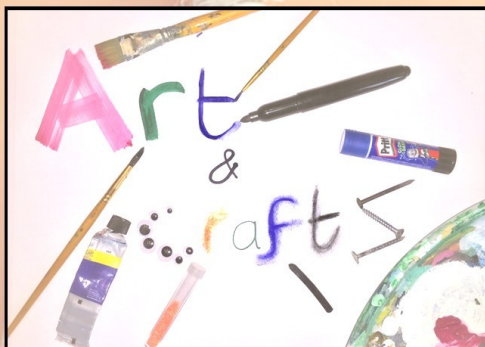
